One team member will rider a prelim test, two team members will rider different novice tests and one team member will ride an elementary test.

### **SENIOR / JUNIOR/ MIXED CLASSES**

## **Mixed Intermediate Dressage Eligibility**

**BD Prelim 3 (2024)** Unlimited Prelim points Up to 35 BD points at Novice 0 points at Elementary or above

**BD Novice 2 (2024)** Unlimited Novice points Up to 35 BD points at any higher level

**BD Novice 3 (2024)** Unlimited Novice points Up to 35 BD points at any higher level

**BD Elementary 1 (2024)** Unlimited Elementary points Up to 35 BD points at any higher level

## **Competitions Terms and Conditions**

- This competition will be run under British Riding Club rules. Full details can be found here; <https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook/>
- Dressage tests may be commanded.
- All entries **MUST** be in advance. There will be no entries on the day.
- Please park in a considerate way of others when loading/unloading horses.

There may not be room to tie horses onto vehicles.

- No horse/pony is to be left unattended unless secured in a lorry or trailer attached to a vehicle.
- Please be respectful of the venue and remove all hay and droppings from around horseboxes before leaving.
- Only 8 competitors will be allowed in the warm up area at a time to prevent overcrowding and minimise the risk of accidents. Please be considerate of other riders especially children.
- First Aid provided by “Sharman First aiders”
- Horse Riding is a dangerous sport and you participate at your own risk and without any reliance on Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian or Area 12 for safety of yourself or your property. Due care has been taken to maintain the facilities in a safe condition, but riders must observe the terms and conditions.
- A ‘Riding Hat’ to the relevant standard, must be worn and correctly fastened at all times by anyone, whether competing or not, riding anywhere at the venue.

Hats must have the latest tag - please check with the Official Area 12 Steward and get your hat checked before you ride.

- Riders must bring their own bridle numbers/saddle cloth numbers, and the competitor numbers should be displayed on both sides of the horse/pony.
- The judge’s decision is final. At all times, all competitors and other visitors to the event must adhere to all instructions provided by stewards.
- All accidents or near miss incidents must be reported to KSEC who will record the details.
- Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian Centre have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid accidents and obey the instructions of the organisers and all other officials and stewards at all times.
- ANY INDIVIDUAL USING THE FACILITIES WITHIN THESE PREMISES AT THIS EVENT DOES SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- Please note veterinary cover is not in attendance for this competition. The Stables Equine Practice will be on call. (Payment for any treatment given needs to be made to the vets on the day).
- Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. No Dogs allowed in the arena.
